

# What is Local Government Reorganisation (LGR)?

**Local Government Reorganisation** refers to the process of restructuring local government authorities or councils.



The Government wants to simplify how councils work by **replacing the current two-tier system** with a new, streamlined approach.

#### How does LGR differ from Devolution?

Aspect	Devolution	Local Government Reorganisation
Definition	Transfer of powers and funding from central government to local or regional bodies	Structural changes to how local councils are organised or operate
Purpose	Increase local autonomy and democratic accountability	Improve service delivery, reduce costs, or simplify governance.
Scope	Often involves legislative or fiscal powers.	Typically involves boundaries, roles, or number of councils
Governance Impact	May introduce a combined authority and elected mayor	Replaces two-tier system with a single-tier council
Funding	Includes financial packages (e.g. £24m/year for 30 years in Lincolnshire)	Generates savings through efficiencies and reduced bureaucracy
Example	Creation of devolved governments in Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland	Merging district councils into a unitary authority


